

Directions

Buses

The following buses operate along Old Kent Road, with the nearest bus stop to the IWMF being Commercial Way, close to Devon Street.

21 - Newington Green to Lewisham (N21 - 24hr) (via London Bridge)

53 - Plumstead to Whitehall (24hr) (via Elephant & Castle)

172 - St. Paul's Station to Brockley Rise (via Waterloo Station and Elephant & Castle)

453 - Deptford to Marylebone (24hr) (via Charing Cross and Elephant & Castle)

P12 - Surrey Quays to Brockley Rise (via South Bermondsey Rail)

Trains

Queens Road, Peckham (5 mins from London Bridge and Victoria Station)

South Bermondsey (2 mins from London Bridge Station)

New Cross Gate (10 mins from London Bridge Station)

Driving

The A2 Old Kent Road is a primary route running northwest to southeast between Central London, Southeast London and Kent.

The major junction to the northwest is Elephant & Castle roundabout

and to the southeast is New Cross Gate gyratory. This site is accessed via Devon Street, which is a one way street. There are limited parking spaces available and these are issued on a 'first come, first served' basis.
